## 1. PURPOSE & SCOPE

The purpose of this Policy is to demonstrate Horizon Energy Groups’ commitment to environmental management. This policy applies to all staff, contractors and visitors who are involved in any activity conducted by or on behalf of the Horizon Energy Group.

## 2. POLICY

- Identify and manage environmental risks, aspects and impacts on the environment that may arise from work activities, or external factors, in line with requirements of ISO 14001.
- Promote a positive culture through staff and subcontractor engagement to ensure our work does not damage the environment or contribute to environmental hazards and/or risks.
- Develop, establish, and continually improve, safe work practices relating to environmental management & control.
- Promote and facilitate the use of products and processes which reduce environmental impact and energy consumption.
- Adopt waste minimisation and recycling strategies in our operations.

Managers and Supervisors are responsible for taking all practical steps to ensure that they:

- Communicate this policy to all staff, subcontractors, and visitors to ensure a suitable level of environmental awareness is promoted.
- Practice the ten fundamentals of our commitment to green growth.
- Comply with legislative, regulatory and project specific contractual requirements.
- Design and implement safe systems of operation.
- Communicate openly with clients, the government, and our community on environmental matters.
- Promote the reporting of environmental hazards and risks by all staff and ensure a system is in place to assess the environmental impact and response if deemed necessary.
